Dear People of God, Easter Greetings

We extend our sincere gratitude to His Grace, The Most Revd. Dr. Thabo Makgoba, who visited the Diocese on Tuesday, 31 March 2026, to present the Report from the Intervention Task Team (ITT), established by the Synod of Bishops in 2025.

Archbishop Thabo had invited the Anglican Bishops in Gauteng, namely Bishop Vicentia Kgabe (Pretoria), Bishop Mkhuseleli Sobantwana (Christ the King), Bishop Sephadi Moruthane (Johannesburg), and Bishop William Mostert (Retired Bishop of Christ the King)

The ITT was represented by Bishop Eddie Daniels, retired Bishop of Port Elizabeth, and Mr Titus Lebeso, Diocesan Administrator of Pretoria. They both delivered the report following Bishop Eddie's submission of the report to the Diocese and the Archbishop. To facilitate the processes of resetting, repairing, and reconciliation, a dedicated team within the Diocese has been formed to work towards these three objectives. The team will include a trained mediator to chair and lead the process, alongside an accountant to oversee financial matters. In order to ensure the credibility and transparency of this process, I have voluntarily decided to extend my Sabbatical until its completion. Archbishop will appoint the Vicar General and a retired Bishop for Episcopal Ministry.

Nonetheless, I remain available should I be called upon for any questions or clarifications. I humbly request that you include this process in your prayers, as you have previously supported other initiatives. John 12:20-26 was the reflection at the meeting. Please read as you pray.
